## **Eligibility Requirements**

- An Honours Bachelor's degree of the University of Moratuwa and a minimum period of experience of one (01) year;
- Any other four (04) year degree from a recognised University and a minimum period of experience of one (01) year as may be approved by the Senate;
- Any other three (03) year degree from a recognised University and a minimum period of experience of two (02) years as may be approved by the Senate;
- Any recognized category of membership of a recognized professional institute, obtained through an academic route, with a minimum period of experience of two (02) years as may be approved by the Senate

All qualified applicants will be notified of their eligibility and will be invited for a selection test and a subsequent interview conducted by the Department of Computer Science & Engineering. The postgraduate degree programs of the Computer Science & Engineering Department will commence on **05**<sup>th</sup> **January 2019.**
